Our nurses work very hard to provide patients and their families and carers with the support and treatment that they need. One way in which your company can help us is by sponsoring a nurse.

It costs £20,000 a year for a St Barnabas nurse, and we have many nurses around Lincolnshire who are able to offer emotional and practical support. Wherever you are in Lincolnshire, there is a St Barnabas nursing team working in your area, supporting people in your community.

To sponsor a nurse, it is:

£55 per day

£385 per week

£1,670 per month

£20,000 per year

You can choose what length of time you'd like to sponsor a nurse for, and can either donate it as a lump donation, or pledge to raise that amount within your business.
