



Terms and Conditions of Entry

Colour Dash Fest 2020

- In the event you are no longer able to attend Colour Dash, your registration fee can only be refunded up until Monday 27th April 2020 at 16:00.
- Once accepted, your place cannot be transferred or refunded after Monday 27th April 2020. If you cannot attend the Colour Dash, you must inform St Barnabas Lincolnshire Hospice as soon as possible. We ask that you return your sponsorship form.
- You must ensure you have completed an emergency contact name and telephone number on your wristband along with any relevant medical details. This should not be someone participating in the event.
- By registering for Colour Dash you agree to fundraise the minimum sponsorship of your respective distance.
- You are not authorised to raise money for any other charity or organisation. If you do not pass all the money that you raise to St Barnabas Lincolnshire Hospice, you may be committing a criminal offence.
- Payment: Please make cheques payable to St Barnabas Lincolnshire Hospice. Each cheque should have the name(s) of the Dashers written on the back. Please, do not send cash through the post.
- Participants in the 5K event must be 5 years or older by 16 May 2020. Anyone under the age of 16 years must be accompanied by an adult who must also be registered for the event.
- Disabled entrants are welcome to take part, although due to the nature of the event we ask that you contact us prior to registering for the event. We recommend using an all-terrain wheelchair. If a disabled entrant requires assistance from another person, this person must also be registered as a registered Dasher.
- Colour Dash 5K, 10K and 15K are not timed runs. You can run, jog or walk the course.
- All participants take part at their own risk. If you suffer from any medical conditions which may affect you during this event, please consult your GP. In no event shall St Barnabas Lincolnshire Hospice be liable for any injuries, loss or damages whatsoever including indirect, punitive, special, incidental or consequential losses connected with any aspect of this event.
- Only guide dogs are accepted on site – no pets or animals are permitted on the course.
- Coloured paint powder is non-toxic and biodegradable. It is made from natural corn starch. If participants have a known skin allergy or respiratory condition we recommend that they seek medical advice before registering to take part.

- All participants will be provided with free sunglasses on the day. First aiders will be present during the event. First aiders will carry eye wash and there will be water for medical support on each paint station.
- You are not permitted to use any of the sponsorship money you raise to pay for your expenses.
- You must pass sponsorship monies, together with used and unused sponsorship forms, directly to St Barnabas Lincolnshire Hospice by 23rd June 2020. If you do not pass all the money that you raise to St Barnabas Lincolnshire Hospice, you may be committing a criminal offence.
- By registering yourself and others either online or offline you agree to follow the reasonable directions of St Barnabas Lincolnshire Hospice and abide by the rules and conditions of entry for the Colour Dash Fest event.
- Please note that photography and filming for publicity purposes will take place throughout the event. By taking part in this event you authorise the use of your picture for future St Barnabas Lincolnshire Hospice publications, online, in the media and to help publicise future events.
