

NO.8 4mm Double Knitting SWEET EASTER BUNNIES

Measurements: 13cm [15in] in height to tops of ears.

**Eyes Required:** Two 7mm for each bunny. Note: The double thickness body Piece is designed to hold a small, filled chocolate egg for example a Cadbury crème egg.

#### <u>Body</u>

Using light Turquoise or pink (any colour of your liking, please feel free to get creative with patterns and colours). Cast on 28sts and g-st 27 rows. Cast Off.

Make up using Method 1, but do not stuff. Push the second set of gathered row ends right inside the piece, so that both sets of row ends are together. Now push the chocolate egg right inside the body. Leave the egg inside when adding all the other pieces. Catch the two sets of gathered row ends together.

### <u>Head</u>

Using light fawn cast on 10 sts and g-st 27 rows. Cast off.

Make up using **Method 1**. Pin, the sew head to top of body, matching the two sets of gathered row ends. Glue on the eyes, with one g-st ridge between them. **Ears** 

# [Make 2]

Using light fawn cast on 7sts and g-st 9 rows. Cast Off.

With right side outside, make up using **Method 1**, but do not stuff. Sew ears side-by-side to top of head.

## <u>Arms</u>

[Make 2]

Using light fawn cast on 8st and g-st 9 rows. Cast off.

With right side outside, making up using **Method 1,** oversewing lightly, sew tops of arms to sides to body just below 'neck'. Catch arms to body a little further down. **Tail** 

Make as given for easter bunny's Tail, page 9. – Using white wool – cast on 4st gst 9 rows, cast off. Sew to the center back of body piece at lower edge.

### Bow

Using yellow cast on 26 sts, then cast off. From the strip into a bow-shape. Tie a length of yellow yarn tightly round the center, then use this to sew bow to body under the chin.
