Terms and Conditions

There is a non-refundable registration fee of £50 and we ask you to pledge to raise £350 for St Barnabas Hospice (minimum £400 total).

In addition to your registration fee, £34 of the funds that you raise will cover your race fees and the remaining money (minimum £316) will directly fund patient care and support across Lincolnshire.

Any monies raised over the minimum sponsorship of £316 would be greatly appreciated and would go a long way in helping us to provide care across our services.

If on the day of the GNR, and you are unable to participate, you will not receive a refund of any monies paid.

Please note that match funding from companies cannot be included in your £350 minimum sponsorship - this is classed as additional sponsorship.

For you to participate, you must cover the cost of the charity place in the GNR which is £84.00. In addition to £175.00 minimum sponsorship 6 weeks prior to the GNR taking place.

Monies can be paid in several ways such as cheque, card or cash. Payments can be taken over the phone by credit/debit card by calling 01522 540300.

Failure to fundraise, may result in the cancellation of your GNR charity place and no monies will be refunded. This procedure is in place, so the Hospice do not incur costs which detract from the hospice care that we provide.

All payments are non-refundable even if you do not take part in the skydive for any reason. By signing up to the GNR charity place you are committed to raising the £316 minimum for the Hospice in addition to the cost of the GNR Charity place.

If you choose to fundraise via an online platform such as Enthuse or JustGiving, all your sponsorship monies will be automatically transferred to us.

If you have only raised part of the money required via your online page or have received offline sponsorship, you will need to ensure the outstanding balance is paid no later than two weeks after your GNR run has taken place.
