Terms and Conditions: Skydive 2025

If you have selected the **'fundraising'** option, your £480 minimum sponsorship is made up of;

- £85 non-refundable registration fee which secures your place on the skydive.
- £144 remaining skydiving fees (must be raised 8 weeks prior to skydive)
- £251 sponsorship which goes directly to patient care.

If you have selected the **'self-funded'** option, your £480 minimum sponsorship is made up of;

- £229 non-refundable registration fee which secures your place on the skydive.
- £251 sponsorship which goes directly to patient care.

Any monies raised over the minimum sponsorship of £480 would be greatly appreciated and would go a long way in helping us to provide care across our services.

Skydive Hibaldstow have provided The Tandem Student Self-Declaration Medical form 115A which all tandem students must read in the first instance. If you can agree to all statements within this form, then you are able to self-declare your fitness. If you cannot agree to any of the statements within this form a Doctor's Stamped and Signed Certificate form 115B must be completed by your doctor. A copy of your completed form must then be presented to Skydive Hibaldstow on the day of your skydive.

If on the day of the skydive, you do not meet the medical requirements and are unable to participate, you will not receive a refund of any monies paid, however you may be responsible for paying a re-booking fee. This cost will not be passed on to St Barnabas Hospice and must be paid by the individual.

Once registered, if you are unable to participate, you will not be eligible for a refund of any payments made. You will be responsible for informing any supporters who have donated to your page that you can no longer take part. If they wish to request a refund, they must contact the fundraising platform where their donation was made.

Please note that match funding from companies cannot be included in your £480 minimum sponsorship - this is classed as additional sponsorship.

For you to participate, you must cover the cost of the skydive which is £229. You must raise this amount **10 weeks** prior to the skydive taking place. Should you not raise the full skydive costs in the timeframe set out above, a member of the St Barnabas Hospice Fundraising Team will contact you to discuss further fundraising activities and/or arrange full payment.

Monies can be paid in several ways such as cheque, card or cash. Payments can be taken over the phone by credit/debit card by calling 01522 540300.

Failure to fundraise/pay the skydiving costs, may result in the cancellation of your skydive and no monies will be refunded. This procedure is in place, so the Hospice do not incur costs which detract from the hospice care that we provide.

All payments are non-refundable even if you do not take part in the skydive for any reason. By signing up to the skydive you are committed to raising the £251 minimum for the Hospice in addition to the cost of the skydive.

If you choose to fundraise via an online platform such as Enthuse or JustGiving, all your sponsorship monies will be automatically transferred to us.

If you have only raised part of the money required via your online page or have received offline sponsorship, you will need to ensure the outstanding balance is paid no later than two weeks after your skydive has taken place.

By signing up for the skydive in support of St Barnabas Hospice you accept these terms and conditions and have read the information provided by Skydive Hibaldstow that include medical requirements.
