Registration and Sponsorship Commitment

Gift Aid

As you have paid the full cost of your participation, any sponsorship raised can be eligible for Gift Aid:

- If the donations have been made by individuals who are UK taxpayers, and they meet the usual Gift Aid criteria.
- By completing a Gift Aid declaration, St Barnabas Hospice can claim an additional 25p for every £1 donated, at no extra cost to the donor.
