About us

The Hospice in a Hospital is a unique partnership between United Lincolnshire Hospitals Trust Lincolnshire ICB and St Barnabas Hospice.

Who is Hospice in the Hospital for?

Patients come to the Hospice in the Hospital for different reasons; they may need help to control pain or other symptoms which impact on their quality of life and will be discharged after a short stay, while other patients may require end of life care.

How long do people stay in the Hospice in the Hospital?

The Hospice in the Hospital is not a long stay unit. The length of stay varies from patient to patient, most of the patients at the Hospice in the Hospital stay for around two weeks. However this may be more or less, depending on each person's situation.

What is the Hospice in the Hospital like?

The Hospice in the Hospital has six single rooms with en-suite facilities and access to a landscaped courtyard. During your stay nurses, health care support workers, physiotherapists, occupational therapists, doctors and other healthcare professionals will care for you around the clock. It is a peaceful place that provides outstanding care to patients with complex needs.

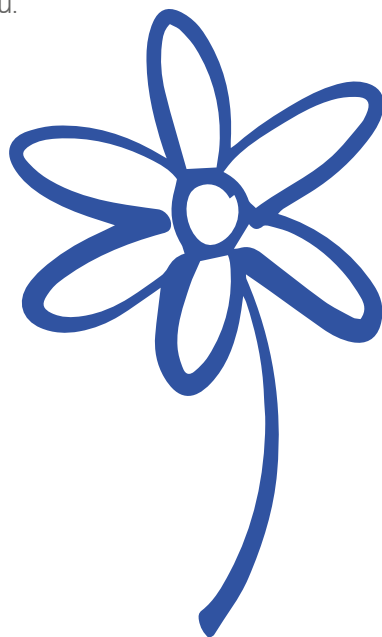
What should I bring?

Please bring with you all the medicines that you are currently taking, including any over the counter medicine or alternative therapies.

You will also need to bring the following:

- Night and day clothes
- Toiletries, including soap, a toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo and conditioner
- Glasses/hearing aid/dentures
- Things to do, such as books, magazines or puzzle books
- Electrical equipment - health and safety regulation requires the Trust to test all electrical equipment before use. This includes laptops, handheld games consoles, radios etc. Please speak to a member of staff who can organise this on your admission.

There are no facilities for laundering clothes, so please ask your visitors to do this for you.





What about personal property such as money?

Please do not bring valuables or large sums of money with you. We regret that we cannot accept responsibility for money or valuables that are not handed in for safekeeping.

What is the smoking policy?

E-cigarettes and vaping will still be permitted within outdoor areas of the Trust, as long as it is not done in close proximity to others.

Are there visiting hours?

The Hospice in the Hospital has an open visiting policy, which means that friends and family are able to visit you at any time – day or night.

Can visitors stay overnight at the Hospice in the Hospital?

Yes, visitors are able to stay overnight if your condition deteriorates. There is a relatives' room with a bed, and

recliner chairs if you would rather they stay by your bedside. Your visitors can stay overnight by discussing it with the nurse in charge.

Where can visitors park?

There are a limited number of car park spaces for patients and relatives right outside the entrance to the Hospice in the Hospital. If these spaces are full, then please park in the main car park.

In both cases, you must get a parking pass from the Hospice reception so that you do not have to pay the cost of parking.
